

“Saddle Up” for the St Jude Trail Ride

Ulupalakua- Its time to plan a horse and solicit pledges for Maui’s 25th annual “Saddle Up” St Jude Trail Ride Saturday September 23. Horse and riders enjoy a spirited 10 mile ride from Thompson Road to the Fleming Arboretum within the Puu Mahoe cinder-cone through private lands of Ulupalakua and OW Ranch. Riders are treated with the traditional cowboy stew made by Uncle Joe and his wife Aunty Gwen De Rego. There will be door prizes and Awards.

The annual St. Jude Trail Ride raises funds for the St Jude Children’s Research Hospital. Thompson Ranch has organized Maui’s St. Jude Trail ride each year since 1992, generating more than \$360,000 in donations. All funds donated go directly to helping the children at the hospital who have cancer and other serious illnesses.
